Diane Lowry (Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church) was commissioned as a Lay Pastor.

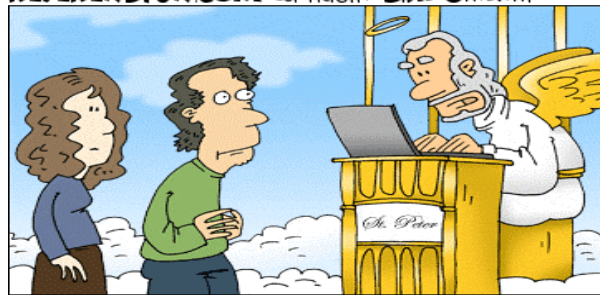

CPF Unanimously Passes Woodbury Motion to Clarify Amendment 10-A

Following defeat of a motion from the floor to amend the wording of a motion brought by Woodbury Presbyterian Church to clarify the new wording of G6.01065b, the motion was passed and the following wording will be used to evaluate all candidates for the office of Minister of the Word and Sacrament:

"We believe that when the Book of Order states in G6.01065b that 'standards for ordained service reflect the church's desire to submit joyfully to the Lordship of Jesus Christ in all aspects of life' that this means among other things that officers in the church are required to live either in fidelity within the covenant of marriage between a man and a woman (W49001), or chastity in singleness. Persons refusing to live according to these requirements shall not be received, ordained or installed as ministers of the word and sacrament in Central Florida Presbytery."
